

Vacaville Junior Varsity rally comes up short

VACAVILLE - Vacaville High School's junior varsity football team rallied late but fell short in a 29-15 loss to visiting Granite Bay at Tom Zunino Stadium.

The Bulldogs (0-3) committed five turnovers, but bounced back and pulled within seven points with four minutes left.

Kyle Castro ran 2 yards for Vacaville's second score after the Bulldogs used a littl bit of trickery. Quarterback Nate Villalobos passed to wide receiver Austin Roe, who pitched the ball to Isiah Edwards for a 47-yard hook-and-lateral play.

Edwards added a 2-point conversion run to make the score 22-15, but Granite Bay countered with a late score for the final total.

Villalobos scored Vacaville's first touchdown on a 2-yard quarterback sneak with 16 seconds left in the third period. Sam Patel added the extra point.

Bulldogs also recieved strong defensive plays from Isiah Burks, Michael McCauley, Eric Britton, AJ Lovett and Quinten Cardoza.
