

Consistent Bulldogs roll past Mustangs, 42-10

The Vacaville High football team scored two touchdowns in each of the first three quarters and opened defense of its Monticello Empire League championship with a 42-10 victory over Rodriguez at Coach Ed Hopkins Memorial Stadium, Friday.

The Mustangs dropped to 0-6 for the first time in their history with the seventh consecutive setback.

Nick Pine threw a 25-yard touchdown pass to Michael Otterstedt and Coulter Malone had a 2-yard TD run to put the Bulldogs (4-2) ahead 14-0 in the first quarter after the first two of Chris Sacca's five conversion kicks.

Vacaville upped its lead to 28-0 in the second quarter with Geremiah Brown and Chris Island scoring on runs of 3 and 4 yards, respectively.

A fumble recovery by Logan Kuehl set up Rodriguez's first score, a 10-yard run by David Salgado with Cyril Osifo-doe's point after making it 28-7 at halftime.

Vacaville added touchdowns in the third quarter on an 11-yard run by Leon Guerrero and a 2-yard run by Logan Cunningham.

A fumble recovery set up Rodriguez's final score, a 30-yard field goal by Osifo-doe.

This Friday's games have Vacaville hosting Vanden at Will C. Wood, a contest that decided the MEL title last year, while Rodriguez goes to Fairfield.
