

Vaca's JV team roars on Armijo

October 14, 2006 - The Vacaville junior varsity football team defeated Armijo 35-13 at Tom Zunino Stadium.

Kyler Martin had touchdown catches of 35 and 7 yards and caught another 2-point conversion to help the Bulldogs improve to 5-1 and 1-0 in the Monticello Empire League.

Taylor Goodson, who played well at safety, also had a 15-yard run in the first quarter. Spencer Lukehart, who made plays at outside linebacker, also had a 10-yard rushing score in the third quarter. Lukehart had about 80 rushing yards and kicked for four extra points.

Scott Lowery finished the Indians with a 5-yard score in the final quarter.

Defensive tackle Ben Holmes and cornerback Jesse Beard played well for defensive coordinator Adam Wight"s charges.

"One-and-zero. It"s all about being 1-0 for us. It was a nice night. We moved down the field on the first drive about 70-plus yards," Vacaville head coach Sarj Singh said. "When we get rolling, it"s tough to stop us."

Vacaville will play its biggest games of the season the next two weeks on the road against Vintage and Napa.
