

Vacaville High School football team routs Armijo

Vacaville High quarterback Ryan Vaughan threw for three touchdowns and ran for another Friday as the Vacaville High football team routed host Armijo 49-0.

The Bulldogs scored 35 points in the first quarter and 14 more in the second quarter. They put up 399 yards of total offense.

Vacaville is 5-2 overall and 2-0 in the Monticello Empire League.

Vaughan, the 6-foot-3 senior was 7-for-9 for 128 yards passing with three TDs and he rushed for 110 yards on just four carries with another score.

The quarterback started the scoring with a 30-yard touchdown to Timothy Plowman and then he scored himself on a 76-yard touchdown jaunt. Plowman scored the third touchdown when he intercepted a pass and returned it for a touchdown.

Vaughan then fired an 11-yard touchdown to Cameron Faucher and Amani Holliday competed the first-quarter scoring with a seven-yard touchdown.

In the second quarter, Vaughan fired a 25-yard touchdown strike to Anthony Wiley as Vacaville led 42-0. Finally, Finn Chapman ran in a score from five yards out to complete the scoring.

Plowman and Joseph Kuntz both had interceptions.

The Royals fell to 1-6 overall, 0-2 in the MEL. Armijo had 129 passing yards but only 38 rushing yards.
