



Vacaville football team wins season opener

Area powerhouse Vacaville High School came away a victory in season football opener Friday night.

Vacaville hung tight with visiting Escalon, winning 23-21 behind 126 rushing yards from Tanner Boyd.

Vacaville quarterback Jimmy Macniven completed nine of 15 passes for 154 yards and two touchdowns. Jaden Beamon-Santos caught one of those passes, while Elijah Cline hauled in the other touchdown reception. Cline caught four passes for 59 yards.

Noah Wilcox played well on defense with 19 total tackles, six of them solo. Matthew Parks had 10 total tackles, with three of them solo.

Vacaville, which did not win the Monticello Empire League for the first time in seven years last season, plays at Granite Bay next Friday.
