



Bulldogs swamp Falcons, 43-0

VACAVILLE — Deuces were wild at Zunino Stadium Friday night.

Ryan Vaughan threw for two touchdowns, Darian Leon-Guerrero ran for two more, Lucas Sartorio caught two TD passes and Anthony Wiley scored on a reception and a punt return as the Vacaville High football team cruised to a 43-0 Monticello Empire League win over Fairfield.

Wiley got the first two touchdowns, starting with a 56-yard pass from Vaughan 32 seconds into the game. Just over two minutes later, Wiley returned a punt 45 yards for a TD with Gracie Caulfield kicking the first two of four extra points.

Leon Guerrero rounded out the scoring in the first quarter with TD runs of 2 and 25 yards.

Ariel Till booted a 37-yard goal just over a minute into the second quarter, with Vaughn throwing a 60-yard touchdown toss to Santorio, who later caught a 30-yard TD pass on Alex Barkley's lone attempt of the game.

Vaughan finished 5-of-9 for 152 yards, Leon-Guerrero ran five times for 55 yards and Aiden Roschi led all rushers with 69 yards on four attempts.

Sartorio caught two passes for 90 yards, while Wiley had two receptions for 70 yards.

Fairfield quarterback Corey Oram was 2-for-7 for 47 yards with one interception, while Jerome Neal ran seven times for 14 yards.

The Bulldogs (4-2) are at Armijo on Friday, while Fairfield (0-5), which lost its 24th straight game, hosts Vanden.
