



Vacaville High football team routs Fairfield in MEL opener

VACAVILLE — The Vacaville High football team had no problems with host Fairfield, 43-0 on Friday in the Monticello Empire League opener.

Quarterback Ryan Vaughan was 5-for-9 for 152 yards and had three touchdowns for the Bulldogs, who led 27-0 after a quarter and 43-0 at halftime.

Vaughan started the scoring in the first quarter with a 56-yard touchdown to Anthony Wiley. Vaca scored again when Wiley took a punt and returned it 45 yards to the end zone.

The Bulldogs (4-2, 1-0) made it 21-0 on a Darian Leon-Guerrero 2-yard touchdown and Leon-Guerrero made it 27-0 with a 35-yard touchdown jaunt. Leon-Guerrero finished with five carries for 55 yards.

In the second quarter, Ariel Till nailed a 45-yard field goal and then Vaughan completed a 60-yard touchdown to Lucas Sartorio. The Bulldogs finished the scoring when Alex Barkley threw a 30-yard touchdown strike to Sartorio.

The Bulldogs held the Falcons (0-5, 0-1) to negative-1 rushing yards. Fairfield QB Corey Oram had 47 passing yards.

Alijah Rocha had an interception for the Bulldogs.

Adrian Roschi led Vacaville with 69 yards on four carries. Sartorio had two catches for 90 yards. Wiley had two catches for 70 yards.
