



Vacaville JV beaten by Granite Bay

Vacaville High School's junior varsity football team suffered a heartbreaking, 10-7 loss to visiting Granite Bay Friday night.

The Grizzlies scored the game-winning points on a 35-yard field goal with 49 seconds left.

Vacaville drove from its own 37-yard line and had a chance to tie the game, but the Bulldogs missed a 28-yard field goal with 20 seconds left.

Defense dominated, but Vacaville (2-1-0 overall) finally tied the game on a 3-yard run by Nick Berumen with 6:19 left in the game. The score was set up by a 72-yard run from Terrance Trueblood. Reed White added the extra-point kick for the 7-7 score.

Trueblood also led Vacaville's defense, which shut the Grizzlies out in the first half.

Vacaville plays at Enochs in Modesto next Friday.
