

Peacock sharp as Vaca JV rips Laguna Creek

September 16, 2006 - Even hurt, Ross Peacock was very effective.

Despite a lingering back injury, Peacock threw three touchdown passes to help the Vacaville High School junior varsity football team defeat Laguna Creek 40-28 in the Bulldogs" home opener at Tom Zunino Stadium Friday night.

Peacock only practiced three days last week because of the injury and head coach Sarj Singh said he was even "a little rusty."

Markel Williams also had a big day for the Bulldogs, who improved to 2-0. Williams caught two touchdown passes and ran for two others. He started the scoring with a 12-yard run in the first quarter and followed it with a 57-yard touchdown reception from Peacock.

In the second quarter, Williams had a 93-yard touchdown catch. Spencer Lukehart had a 6-yard touchdown run to make it 28-14 at halftime.

In the second half, Kyler Martin had a 28-yard catch and Williams finished Vacaville"s scoring with a 12-yard scoring run.

"I"m happy we put up 40 points and the first team defense only gave up 14," Singh said. "I think everyone is getting involved on defense."

Vacaville will play at Granite Bay next Friday night.

"Next week, we"re going to put in different looks on special teams and polish our run defense," Singh said.
