



Vaca freshmen easily shut out Laguna Creek

The Vacaville High School freshman football team is on a roll.

After shutting out Rodriguez last week, Vacaville was able to follow up with a dominating 27-0 victory over Laguna Creek on Thursday.

The Bulldogs had two 100-yard rushers, as Melvin Mason had 12 carries for 125 yards, and Reed White recorded 102 yards on 10 carries.

Mason also had an 8-yard touchdown reception on a pass from quarterback Alec Gregorich. White accounted for 17 total points, with two scoring runs and three extra point kicks for Vacaville.

For co-head coach Mike Sullivan, the numbers aren't as important as the players who made them happen.

"We've got 56 players on the team," Sullivan said. "We got every player in, and that is what it is all about at the freshman level. We're getting better every week.

Two key players in the contest were Ralph Vallimont, who recorded 11 tackles, and Terrence Trueblood who added 10.

The Bulldogs (2-0) travel to Granite Bay next week in what will be their biggest game thus far.
