



Vacaville defeats River City 42-14

Vacaville had won two straight road games and Roman Conner-Owens did his part to make it three on Friday. The Bulldogs simply couldn't be stopped as they easily beat the River City Raiders 42-14 with plenty of help from Conner-Owens, who rushed seven times for 131 yards and two scores. He really tore up the turf during one magnificent 80-yard run.

Dylan Borjesson also had a rushing score.

The Bulldogs clinched a share of the MEL title with the road win in West Sacramento and can win the title outright by beating Will C. Wood next Friday.

Jack Williams and Dino Menicou led the Vacaville defense with eight tackles apiece. Brady Wight recorded a sack.

Vacaville didn't go easy on the quarterback and picked off three passes before the game was over. It was truly a group effort as Carter Edmonds, Gabriel Slade, and Jake Williams picked up one apiece.

Quarterback Brendan Jackson finished 14 of 19 passing for 160 yards and two touchdowns. Malakai Hunt also threw a touchdown pass. Brody Rogers, Aiden Pope and Brady Wright had touchdown receptions.

Vacaville's victory bumped their record up to 7-2 and 5-0 in the MEL. As for River City, they are on a four-game losing streak that has dropped them down to 3-6 and 1-4 in MEL play.

Vacaville will be on the road next Friday at Will C. Wood (3-6; 1-4 in MEL) to close out the regular season.
