



Vacaville Skates Past Sacramento with Ease

Vacaville had to skate by with only a one-point margin when they last took the field, which might have inspired the 29-point drubbing they dealt Sacramento on Friday. The Bulldogs took their game with ease, bagging a 42-13 win over the Dragons. The matchup marked the Bulldogs' most dominant victory of the season.

Vacaville had a senior duo take command as Dylan Borjesson rushed for 103 yards and one touchdown on only 11 carries and Roman Conner-Owens rushed for 72 yards and one TD on only seven carries. Conner-Owens also deserves a shoutout for his performance on D, making four total tackles (1.0 for loss) and defending one pass in addition to snagging an interception.

Vacaville was unstoppable on the ground and finished the game with 312 rushing yards. That's the most rushing yards they've posted since back in August.

Vacaville's win was their fourth straight at home, which pushed their record up to 6-2. The home victories came thanks in part to their defensive effort, having only surrendered 12.0 points on average over those games. As for Sacramento, they have been struggling recently as they've lost three of their last four contests. That's put a noticeable dent in their 4-4 record this season.

Vacaville and Sacramento should be looking forward to their upcoming games as both have a sizable advantage in the MaxPreps California Rankings. The Bulldogs (ranked 177th) will meet River City (ranked 558th) at 7:30 p.m. on Friday. Meanwhile, Sacramento will face off against Fairfield at 7:30 p.m. on Friday with a big rank advantage (213 vs. 552).
