



Vacaville High football falls in second round of playoffs

The Vacaville High football team lost in the second round of the Sac-Joaquin Section Division II playoffs on Friday, falling 43-7 to St. Mary's.

The Bulldogs scored in the first quarter, but were outscored by St. Mary's 29-0 the next three quarters in the loss.

Vacaville ends the season with an overall record of 8-4 and finished in second place in the Monticello Empire League with a 5-1 mark.

On Friday the Bulldogs were led by quarterback Brendan Jackson, who completed 14 of 25 passes for 207 yards and a touchdown. His touchdown went to Rome Griego, who caught two passes for 54 yards.

Matthew Parks led Vacaville with 11 tackles, while Noah Wilcox added 10 of his own.

Vacaville had trouble wrapping up St. Mary's running back, Anthony Alexander, who had 194 yards on the ground to go with this three touchdowns.
