



Vaca JV team falls to Vintage

October 21, 2006 - The Vacaville junior varsity football team played Vintage close for a half, but the wheels came off in the second half.

The Bulldogs fell to the Crushers 22-0 at Memorial Stadium despite trailing only 8-0 at halftime.

When the third quarter began, Vacaville struggled. Vintage (2-0 Monticello Empire League) scored on its first possession and Vacaville fumbled on the very next possession. Vintage capitalized with another touchdown to put the game away.
