

Vacaville ends season with a victory

October 27, 2006 - The Vacaville freshman football team ended its season on a strong note by defeating Will C. Wood 20-12 at Tom Zunino Stadium.

After falling behind 6-0, the Bulldogs scored 20 unanswered points to finish the year 5-3.

Jimmy Hines had a 7-yard touchdown run in the second guarter to tie the game 6-6.

On the first play of scrimmage in the second half, Hines ran 57 yards for another score and a 12-6 lead. Blakelyn Birks scored Vacaville"s other third-quarter touchdown on a 9-yard run. Derek Jenkins added a 2-point conversion run for a 20-6 advantage.

Vacaville defensive ends Sanford Graves and Tony Maples played well, along with defensive tackles Jon-Carlos Adley and Alex Forrester. Kalani Agbigay also was a force at linebacker.

Wood quarterback Brett Baker was 7-for-11 for 115 yards with a 12-yard touchdown throw to Damien Ponce.

Ponce had four catches for 91 yards while Brett Babb had three for 54. Preston Williams, who had an interception, ran in for a 3-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter.

A.C. Curiel and James Lopez played well on defense for the Wildcats, who finished 2-5.
