



## **JV Wildcats cruise to big win over Bulldogs**

**November 10, 2006** - *The Will C. Wood High junior varsity football team didn't allow a point until 4:09 in the third quarter of a 33-19 victory over cross-town rival Vacaville at Tom Zunino Stadium on Friday night.*

*Wood's Josh Landers had two touchdown runs in the second half of 39 and 8 yards, respectively, to help the Wildcats (6-3-1 overall, 3-1 Monticello Empire League). With the win, Wood finished second in league play.*

*"It was a huge win for us. This group of kids didn't win a game last year as freshman," Wood head coach Zack Fleming said. "This is why we coach. It's moments like these."*

*Mike McChristian had a 35-yard blocked punt return for the Wildcats' first touchdown and Robert Shafer added a 4-yard TD run in the second quarter for Wood. Justin Gomez had a 1-yard QB sneak to give the Wildcats 19-0 halftime lead.*

*Kyler Martin put Vacaville on the board with 15-yard TD catch from quarterback Ross Peacock to cut Wood's lead to 26-7 in the third quarter.*

*Landers' 39-yard run gave Wood a 33-7 lead with 9:50 left in the fourth quarter. Vacaville scored the last 12 points for the finals margin.*

*The Bulldogs' Jesse Beard's interception set up Ben Holmes' 1-yard TD run and Martin had a 45-yard catch that set up Spencer Lukehart's 2-yard catch from Peacock with 55 second to play.*

*Vacaville finished the season 7-3 overall 3-2 in the MEL*
