



Vaca freshman football races to win over Wood

Jared Paulin had touchdown runs of 10 and 32 yards as the Vacaville High School freshman football team rolled to a 34-8 win at Will C. Wood Thursday afternoon.

Curtis Goin opened the scoring for the Bulldogs with a 56-yard touchdown run in the second quarter. Paulin's scored came in the second and third quarter.

Jim Cheechov had a 10-yard touchdown run and Jordan Whyel raced 37 yards for a score in the fourth quarter. Lucas Sibley converted four extra-point kicks.

Vacaville's defensive tackles Chris Lai and Eric Gabbard helped keep the Wildcats in check.

Wood scored its lone touchdown in the third quarter on a short touchdown run by Jonathon Camacho. Camacho also ran in the 2-point conversion and had 100 yards rushing for the game.

Josh Winters helped lead the Wildcats defense with a sack in the fourth quarter.

Vacaville improved to 3-1 overall and will host Napa on Thursday. Wood is now 1-4 and will play Vintage next Thursday.
