

Vacaville High School's freshman football team rolls over Will C. Wood

Daniel and David Mewborn put the Vacaville High School freshman football team up big at halftime as the Bulldogs rolled to a 53-7 win at Will C. Wood on Thursday.

Daniel Mewborn had touchdown runs of 60, 20 and 62 yards. David Mewborn caught a 40-yard touchdown pass from Justin Milander and later ran 54 yards for a score.

Dylan Lentini's 66-yard interception return for a score gave Vacaville a 46-0 lead at the break. Clayton Caserza added five 2-point conversion runs.

Justin Medina scored the Bulldogs lone touchdown in the second half on a 5-yard run. Daniel Agbigay and Ashton Jacobe led the Vacaville defense.

Vacaville improved to 6-0 overall.

Wood scored in the fourth quarter when Aaron Herbert completed a 35-yard touchdown pass to Tyler Bailey. The Wildcats fell to 0-5.
