



Vacaville High School JV football routs Will C. Wood

Vacaville High School's junior varsity football team wrapped up a banner season with a 41-18 rout over Will C. Wood Friday night at Tom Zunino Stadium.

Jacob Te'o scored on runs of 10, 75 and 67 yards as the Bulldogs finished the year with a perfect 5-0 mark against Monticello Empire League teams, 8-2 overall.

Vacaville jumped out to a huge lead early, but Wood scored twice in the second quarter and trailed just 28-12 at halftime after a 3-yard touchdown pass from Ricky Tauriac to Albert Hightower.

But the Bulldogs took the second half kickoff and marched 80 yards, with Kye Campbell-Jones going the final two yards for a 34-12 lead.

Carson Jeppson added a 30-yard interception return for a score, and Conner Kannalis scored from 19 yards out. Luke Sibley added five extra-point kicks.

Tauriac added a 7-yard scoring pass to Josh Winters, and Jonathan Camacho scored on an 18-yard run for the Wildcats.

Wood finished the season 5-5 overall and 3-2 against MEL teams.

Rezen Anderson added an interception for the Bulldogs, who received solid team defense throughout.

Victor Ruiz recovered a fumble for the Wildcats.
