



Vacaville High School JV football team rushes to victory over Will C. Wood

Vacaville High School's junior varsity football team built a huge lead and finished with a 35-7 victory over Will C. Wood in the Little Black and Blue Bowl at Tom Zunino Stadium on Friday night.

The Bulldogs held the Wildcats scoreless until the final minute of the game, and finished the season 6-3-1 overall and 4-1 against Monticello Empire League teams.

"The whole defense played an excellent game," Vacaville head coach Scott Lopez said. "That, and the O-line stepped it up tonight."

The offensive line play allowed five different running backs to score touchdowns.

Hayden Fry and Pancho Ivie scored on short bursts of 1 and 4 yards, respectively, as the Bulldogs grabbed a 14-0 lead at halftime.

In the third quarter, Demetrius Ward scored on a 10-yard run, and Clayton Caserza added a 6-yard TD run after Daniel Agbigay recovered a Wood fumble.

Daveon Harris scored Vacaville's final touchdown on a 45-yard dash up the middle in the fourth quarter.

Alberto Escobedo added five extra-point kicks for the Bulldogs.

Wood finally got on the scoreboard when Tyler Bailey ran in from three yards out with 59 seconds left. Bailey set up the score with a 30-yard run.

The Wildcats also received solid running from Adam Cunning and Donald Roberts. On defense, Andrew Galvin recovered a fumble, and led Wood in tackles, along with Chris Polen.

For Vacaville, Tanner Donaldson and Connor Cole both intercepted passes. Evan Holaday and Fry joined Agbigay with fumble recoveries.

Wood finished the season with a 6-4 record, 3-2 against MEL teams.
