



Bulldogs run wild in 44-19 win over Yuba City

Vacaville High School's football team rebounded from a close loss to Oak Ridge last week just the way it had hoped.

Behind a 122-yard, four touchdown performance from running back Duvall Jackson, the Bulldogs thumped Yuba City 44-19 Friday night for their first win on the road this season.

Vacaville collected 425 yards of total offense and led 30-6 at the halftime whistle. The Bulldogs held a 37-6 lead midway through the third quarter.

Jackson got things started with three straight touchdowns out of the gate. He scored on runs of 71, 1 and 8 yards before Tre'Vonne Hunt found the end zone from 32 yards out to give Vacaville a 30-6 lead. Hunt also had a 46 yard catch in the win.

Jackson added his fourth touchdown in the third quarter on a two yard run.

Hunter Dorraugh hit Mason Price for a 19-yard touchdown to put the Bulldogs ahead 44-13 in the fourth quarter. Brandon Talton was 4-for-4 on point after field goal attempts.

The Bulldogs picked up 19 first downs on the night, 12 of them coming on the ground.

Vacaville improved to 2-1 on the season and will host Granite Bay (3-0) next Friday at Tom Zunino Stadium.
